ANNUAL SATISFACTION SURVEY

The Regulator of Social Housing has created a system for assessing how well social housing landlords in England are doing at providing good quality homes and services. In addition to introducing revised consumer standards, this will involve a set of tenant satisfaction measures (TSM) that social housing landlords must report on.

Cornerstone have procured a service with a company called CX-Feedback, who specialise in the social housing sector, to carry out these survey's quarterly on our behalf. Customers will receive an invitation to complete a survey to tell us how we are performing.

The information collected from these surveys will tell us about the issues customers are most concerned about and help us to make changes

where they are most needed. We'd be extremely grateful for your co-operation if you're contacted. We will publish the results annually on our website and provide them to the Regulator.

Here's some useful information about the survey if you are contacted:

- It's a general satisfaction survey asking what you think of your home and the services provided by Cornerstone Housing
- The survey should take approximately 5 to 10 minutes to complete
- We are surveying every 3 months but we will only survey you once a year
- If you receive an SMS/text with a link this will show the sender as "Cornerstone"
- If you receive an email with a link this will show the sender as "Cornerstone Housing" from this address:

We will be providing CX-Feedback with data which will enable them to carry out the statistical analysis, the data will not be used for any other purposes.

If you complete the survey you will be entered into a prize draw with a chance of winning a £100 voucher.

WILDFIRE AWARENESS

We have had weeks of dry weather, with more to continue in the coming weeks The Met Office's Fire Severity Index (FSI) is high / very high. This index is an assessment of how severe a fire would be if a fire should start. In hot weather, the grass is dry, and fires will spread quickly.

Beware of wildfires in the coming months and take measures to avoid them. Our advice is to:

- Avoid having bonfires, BBQs or campfires in the countryside (parks or Dartmoor), or on any grassland during this very dry weather.
- If you must use a BBQ, place it on something flat which won't catch alight, such as a stone/paving slabs. Be mindful of sparks and think about the surrounding area. Always keep a large source of water near you to put out the BBQ fire. Remember you must dispose of the coals correctly - they cannot be placed within a bin and take up to 48hr for coal to cool down.
- If you're a smoker, please take extreme care with how you put out your cigarettes and dispose of them.
- Clear up litter. Leaving litter, such as glass bottles, on grass is anti-social but is also a fire risk. The glass magnifies the sun's rays and can cause fires.
- Wildfires are more frequent this time of year. Find out how you can prevent wildfires.

LOOKING TO MOVE?

If you are thinking of moving home there are several ways you can do this.

Devon Home Choice

You will need to register and be accepted onto the waiting list for housing and put into a band according to your housing need. You can then 'bid' on up to 3 properties per week. Once bidding for the property has ended the landlord will go through the list of applicants starting with the person who finished in position number 1. If this person declines the property or it is deemed not suitable for them the next person on the list will be contacted. The shortlist is ordered according to your banding and the length of time you have been registered. To register on Devon Home Choice please visit **www.devonhomechoice.com**

Mutual Exchange

A mutual exchange is where you 'swap' your home with a different tenant. For most swaps you will need to prove that the home you are hoping to move into is suitable for your needs. For example it should have the number of bedrooms you require (no more or less). To search for potential exchange partners visit www.houseexchange.org.uk Cornerstone are a partner of House Exchange so there is no charge to sign up.

Downsizing

If you are currently in a Cornerstone property with 3 or more bedrooms and are looking to downsize into a smaller property we may be able to help. We offer a financial incentive for downsizing. Moves via Devon Home Choice and Mutual Exchange are both eligible for the downsizing allowance.

HAPPY HOMES - MOVING IN AND MOVING OUT

MOVING OUT!

If you move out, it's really important that you help us to assess the condition of the property. Our team will arrange an inspection to assess any repairs. The pre-void inspection is the opportunity to identify what is your responsibility and how we can help.

Please make sure you keep the appointment to avoid any recharge costs, unfortunately some customers don't and this has led to recharge costs which in some cases have been over £1,000 or more when the property is returned in poor condition.

DON'T FORGET!

It is really important that you return your keys when you move out, without doing so the tenancy does not end and in some cases we have had to take legal steps which again has been over £1,000 or more cost for our tenant. We will do everything we can to make sure returning the keys is as easy as possible and discuss this with you in advance.
